

# What is TreeKeeper

TreeKeeper® is an inventory management software developed by Davey Tree to help manage tree inventories. It is the repository for data collected on trees located within the City of Bloomington municipal area.

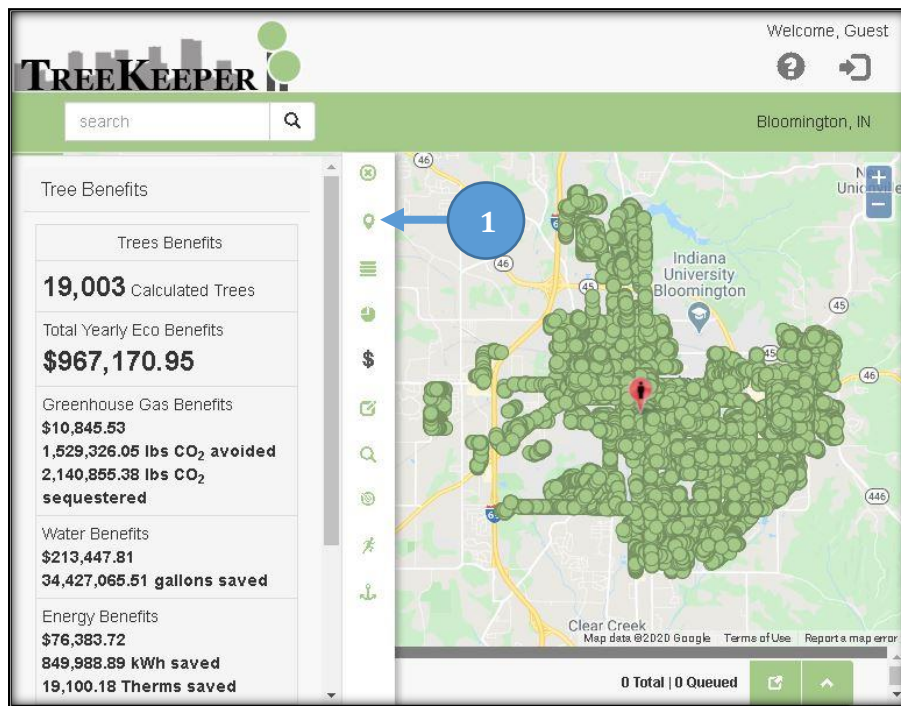
The purpose of this article is to demonstrate how to download all the data contained within TreeKeeper in a format that can be added to a GIS/Mapping software such as ArcGIS or qGIS as points using the latitude and longitude fields in the data.

## How to Download Data from TreeKeeper

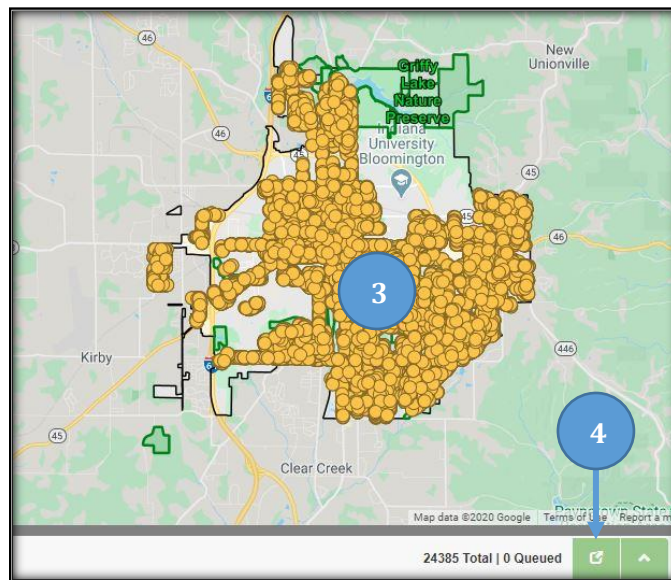
Navigate to the [TreeKeeper Homepage](#). At the home page (below image) the trees in the inventory will appear as green points.



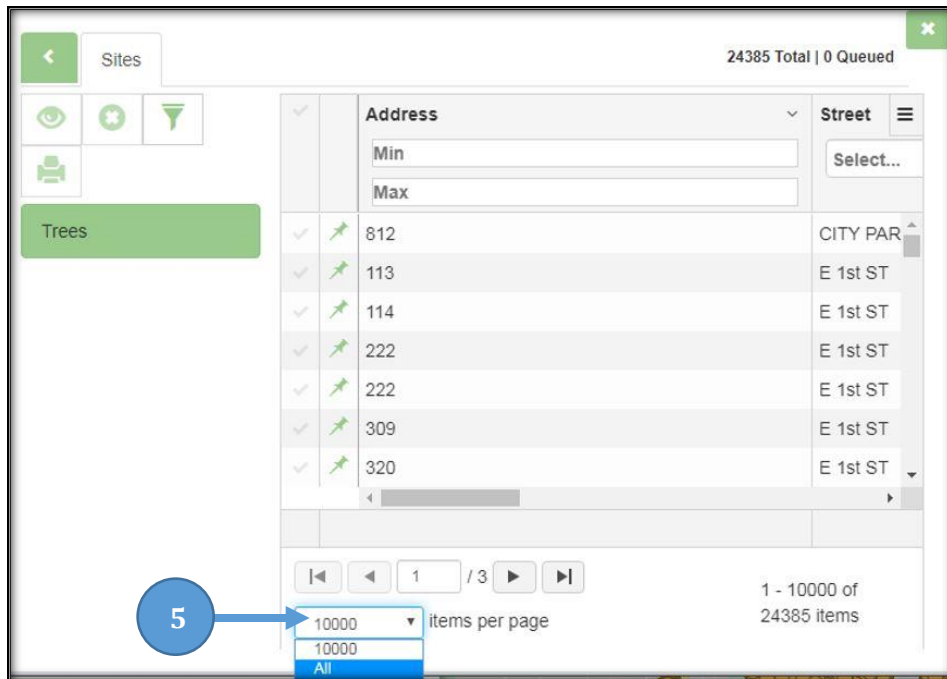
Element	Action
1	Select the <i>Map Tools</i> icon from the Panel Menu



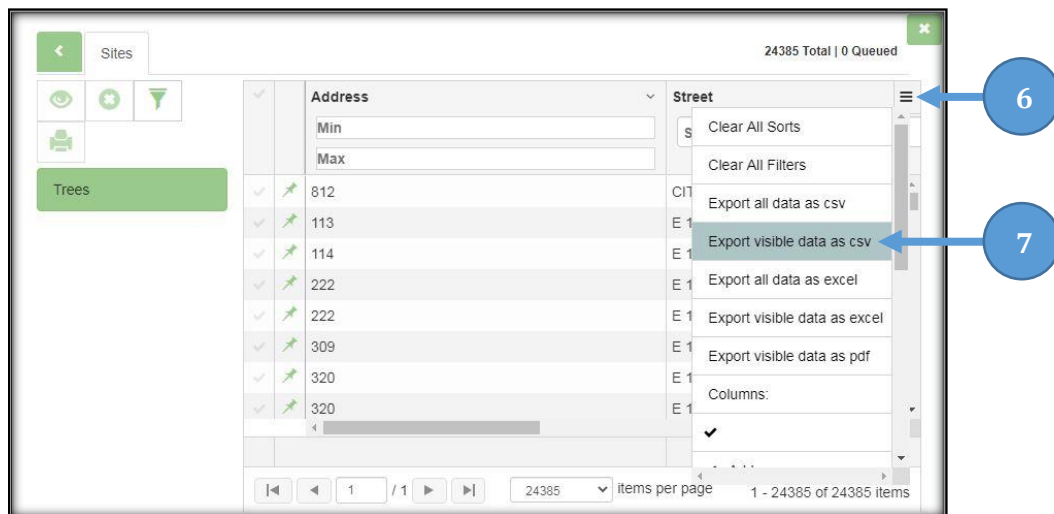
Element	Action
2	Click the Select By Rectangle Tool icon. This will allow you to select the trees you are interested in.



Element	Action
3	Click and drag the rectangle over the desired area and release when finished. The selected trees will turn orange
4	Once your trees are selected, click the Report Generator button at the bottom right corner



Element	Action
5	Make sure to select All in the items per page dropdown to ensure you download all the selected trees



Element	Action
6	Click the Hamburger Icon
7	Click Export visible data as csv
8	Save the csv to the desired location
